Assignment

2. Using your timer and a tripod, set a timer to capture self-portraits.
3. Capture 20+ images that reveal 2 different sides to yourself
4. Edit 2 final images, one for each perception.
5. Upload your final **2 Images** for Unit G on your Weebly Photo II page.
